



Violence Prevention Labrador (VPL)

Guidelines for Funding

Violence Prevention Labrador (VPL) has funding available for community projects of ***up to \$500.00***. This money will be available to organizations in the Labrador to implement anti-violence/ Violence Prevention activities in their local areas. Groups will be asked to submit proposals to the VPL Board, following these guidelines:

- 1) The proposed activities must be clearly defined, and fit within at least one of the key objectives of the Provincial Violence Prevention Initiative:
 - Public Awareness and attitudinal change regarding violence.
 - Activities that include any of the vulnerable populations; women, children and youth, Aboriginal women and children, seniors, persons with disabilities and others who are victims of violence because of ethnicity, sexual orientation, or economic status
 - Education and Training
- 2) Goals, objectives and project activities must be outlined, including dates, locations, target populations, etc.
- 3) Anticipated costs of the project must be outlined in detail.
- 4) Once money is received, acknowledgement must be forwarded to Treasurer.
- 5) All receipts must be kept by project organizers and submitted to the Treasurer upon completion of the project upon request.
- 6) Money received must only be used for activities described in the proposal. Any change of plans must be first submitted to VPL.
- 7) Money must be used before the end of the fiscal year in which money is given.

Deadlines for Funding

Application deadlines are January 15th, April 15th, July 15th, and October 15th. Applications will be reviewed within one week of deadlines and notifications sent out shortly thereafter.
